Facilities

Park regulations

The following summary of regulations was developed to protect the natural and cultural resources of Emigrant Lake Park and to ensure your safety and enjoyment.

1. Park closure for all areas occurs at sunset unless otherwise posted.
2. Hunting or discharging of firearms is prohibited.
3. Camping only allowed in designated areas.
4. Fires allowed only in designated camping areas.
5. Please put trash in receptacles provided or pack it out with you.
6. Wood cutting, plant collecting, destruction of plant life or removal thereof is prohibited.
7. Removal or displacement of cultural or natural material is prohibited.
8. Driving off designated roads is prohibited.
9. Leaving a vehicle unattended within the park for more than 12 hours is prohibited without prior approval from the county.
10. Aircraft are prohibited from landing within park boundaries without prior approval from the county.
11. Please follow all boating, camping and county park regulations.

Regulations are enforced by Jackson County Roads and Park Services, Bureau of Reclamation, Oregon State Marine Board and the Jackson County Sheriff. The regulations are based on Jackson County Ordinance Chapter 1064.
